- 1. What are typical ways children act when they think they've been caught doing something wrong?
- 2. Read Genesis 3:7. Facing what we really are can be very fearful because doing so reveals our weaknesses. In the process of building relationships, what kinds of life situations can make someone feel shameful?
- 3. Read Genesis 3:3. Out of fear, we may keep a distance from others to cover up disgrace or embarrassment instead of facing our fears. How might someone face their fears instead of ignoring them?
- 4. Read Genesis 3:8. Like Adam and Eve, when we don't follow God's instructions we often find ourselves hiding from God and feeling far from him. What are reasons people hide from and distance themselves from God?
- 5. Read 1 Corinthians 13:7. What does it look like to offer the type of love described in 1 Corinthians 13:7 to people who are often demanding or difficult?
- 6. Read John 13:34. Imagine that you accept others as Christ has accepted you. How can offering this kind of love to others change our perspective when dealing with relationships we struggle with?
- 7. Read Job 11:13-18. How might surrendering our hearts to God help to alleviate fear and replace it with confidence? How could sharing this victory with others encourage them to surrender their fears to God?
- 8. What are typical ways people cover up fears regarding things they don't like about themselves in order to keep other people at a distance relationally?
- 9. Remembering the ways God loves and values us is one antidote to fear. What makes each of us valuable as a person?
