

#### SMALL GROUP SERMON DISCUSSION

- 1. Discuss what you think is the difference between joy and happiness.
- 2. Look at the three killjoys. Which one affects you the most when it comes to losing joy in your relationships?
- 3. Read Philippians 4:4. Is it realistic to be full of joy <u>all</u> the time? Now read 2 Corinthians 11:23-31. This is written by the same person who wrote Philippians 4:4. Does this put a different light on your discussions?
- 4. Why do we have this image of God as a sombre, serious, dour, big, divine, cosmic killjoy? How has the church given people this perception when the Bible says that God is full of joy? How have you given people this perception of God?
- 5. Zephaniah 3:17. How does that make you feel that God rejoices over you with singing?
- 6. Joy is the presence of God. It's not the removal of suffering and pain and difficulty. It is the awareness that there is a God who is with you in the midst of the suffering and the difficulty. How does the presence of God in our lives help us to live with joy each day?
- 7. How does realising the extent that God loves you raise the level of joy in your life? See John 15:9&11.
- 8. How does our joy in the Lord affect how we love others? See John 15:9-12 and follow the flow of thought.
- 9. In what ways is the joy of the Lord our strength? See Nehemiah 8:10.
- 10. Read 1 Peter 1:6-8 to encourage each other before you pray together.
