How the resurrection answers the biggest question of life.
Matthew 28:1-10

"Don't be troubled. You trust God, now trust in me. There are many rooms in my Father's home, and I am going to prepare a place for you. If this were not so, I would tell you plainly. When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am. And you know where I am going and how to get there." "No, we don't know, Lord," Thomas said. "We haven't any idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?" Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me."

1. Consider the _____ of Jesus.

'When the teachers of the law who were Pharisees saw Jesus eating with the 'sinners' and tax collectors, they asked His disciples, "Why does He eat with tax collectors and sinners?" On hearing this, Jesus said to them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." Mark 2:16-17 NIV

2. Consider the _____ of Jesus.

'Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.' Luke 23:34 NIV

'Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last.' Luke 23:46 NIV

'There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men. The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said."' Matthew 28:2-6 NIV
