Counter Cultural Church ~7 How to worship at all times. Acts 16:16-34

Worship means to declare 'Because of God's great mercy to us offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, dedicated to His service and pleasing to Him. This is the true worship that you should offer.' Romans 12:1 TEV

WE CAN WORSHIP GOD AT ALL TIMES BECAUSE:
1. He alone is worthy of 'Once when we were going to the place of prayer, we were met by a slave girl who had a spirit by which she predicted the future. She earned a great deal of money for her owners by fortune-telling. This girl followed Paul and the rest of us, shouting, "These men are servants of the Most High God, who are telling you the way to be saved." She kept this up for many days.' Acts 16:16-17 NIV
'Finally Paul became so troubled that he turned round and said to the spirit, "In the name of Jesus Christ I command you to come out of her!" At that moment the spirit left her. When the owners of the slave girl realised that their hope of making money was gone, they seized Paul and Silas and dragged them into the market-place to face the authorities. They brought them before the magistrates and said, "These men are Jews, and are throwing our city into an uproar by advocating customs unlawful for us Romans to accept or practise." The crowd joined in the attack against Paul and Silas, and the magistrates ordered them to be stripped and beaten. After they had been severely flogged, they were thrown into prison, and the jailer was commanded to guard them carefully. Upon receiving such orders, he put them in the inner cell and fastened their feet in the stocks.' Acts 16:18-24 NIV
'About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them.' Acts 16:25 NIV
