The glory of the cross.

Mark 15:16-39

'Now my heart is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name!' John 12:27-28 NIV

1. The _____ of the cross.

'If a man guilty of a capital offence is put to death and his body is hung on a tree, you must not leave his body on the tree overnight. Be sure to bury him that same day, because anyone who is hung on a tree is under God's curse.' Deuteronomy 21:22-23 NIV

'Many were amazed when they saw him—beaten and bloodied, so disfigured one would scarcely know he was a person.' Isaiah 52:14 NLT

'As they led Jesus away, Simon of Cyrene, who was coming in from the country just then, was forced to follow Jesus and carry his cross.'
