True Worship ~7 How to worship to the glory of God. 1 Chronicles 16:23-34

'But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever! Amen.' 2 Peter 3:18 NIV

'confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the Glory of God, the Father.' Philippians 2:11 NIV

'Whoever offers praise glorifies Me." Psalm 50:23 NKJV

And as they went, their leprosy disappeared.'

And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well.' Luke 17:15-19 NKJV

- 3. Read 1 Chronicles 16:23-29 which is a great call to worship. List the things we read about God; and in light of this, what should be our response?
- 4. Read Habakkuk 1:12-13 and Habakkuk 3:17-18. How did Habakkuk's perspective change when he focused on God?
 - How can we still glorify God, even when our circumstances haven't changed for the better?
- 5. Read Habakkuk 3:2. If we learn to recite the works of God, how does that give you a different approach to life?
- 6. Read Luke 17:11-19. How does being thankful glorify God?
 - Read 1 Thessalonians 5:18. How could we live this verse each day?
- 7. In John 14:1, Jesus speaks about trusting Him. In what ways can our daily trust in God glorify Him? Where do you need to trust God more?
- 8. 1 Corinthians 10:31 sums up the message. It's often in the everyday mundane things of life that we can glorify God. List some ways you could do that this week.
