- 1. How important is your Bible to you? What's it worth to you? What did it cost?
- 2. William Tyndale's passion, translation of NT, persecution, martyrdom and prayer.
- 3. So, what does this passage tell us about the value of scripture?
- 4. v9 tells us how we can be saved, how we can become part of God's family vital information God has made us a wonderful offer.

- 5. v12 tells us that there are no exceptions everyone has this wonderful offer not just us, but everyone.
- 6. v14&15 tell us the problem we need to know about this wonderful offer before we can respond to it.

- 7. William Tyndale realised that with the Bible not available in English, few people could read about this wonderful offer. Thanks to him, and others, we now can.
- 8. But what about the millions of people across the world who are still waiting for the Bible to be translated into their language? And what about all the people in the world who cannot read? How will they learn of the offer?
- 9. Some 65 years ago, a group of people in Southern England got together to discuss an idea to try to inform more than 500 million people living in East Africa and the Indian subcontinent. Some of those people were part of my home church in Woking in Surrey. They founded Feba, a registered charity and a Christian mission agency that established a radio station in the Seychelles to broadcast the Good News across the Indian Ocean to these highly populated areas.
