#### SMALL GROUP SERMON DISCUSSION

3. Read Hebrews 11:23-27. What first strikes you about Moses in these verses?

5. Why does knowing who you are is going to make you be able to have the confidence to serve other people?
6. Why does learning your true identity give you the courage to let go of the past and gives you the courage to walk into the future?
7. The two most easy mistakes we will make in life are forgetting your identity, who you are, and losing your focus, what God put you here on earth to do. Why is this dangerous and harmful to us and what can we do to avoid making these mistakes? (Look up Hebrews 12:1-2 and Colossians 3:1-2 to help you in your answer).
