

Prayer and Praise for Fresh Start Support Services:

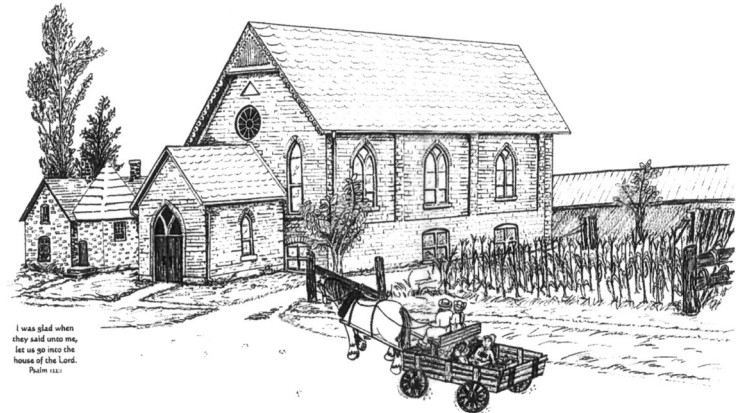
Praise items:
