

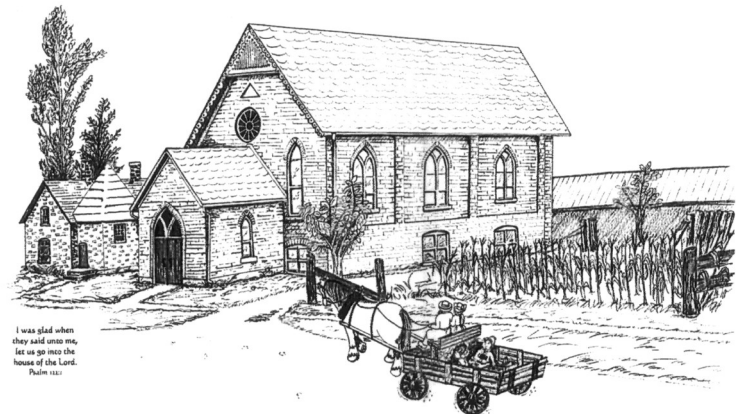

If you have Bibles or Bible study resources, Christian music or sermons on CD/DVD, SS materials, medical or educational books, Christian novels or magazines please bring them to church. We regularly collect in the boxes under the foyer tables and at the end of each month we are able to add them to shipments leaving from Hamilton to be sent overseas. We have been asked specifically to provide in the month of May (pick up May 22).

They also collect any cancelled postage stamps to sell to stamp collectors to help pay for the shipping costs of the materials. Stamps can be added to the jar on the Missions table in the foyer.

From CSM: We started the new year with a nearly blank slate (we cleared out all but two skids of ready-to-ship books just before our December break!), and we want to give thanks to the Lord for His faithfulness and provision in this past year. CSM was able to send six 20-foot sea containers, carrying a total of 186,430 pounds of materials. We are again amazed at how greatly God has multiplied our resources. Thank you to all of our supporters for offering their prayers, books, time, and funds to keep the work of CSM Canada going. Our hope is to reach even more people in 2026 with Bibles and books praising the greatness of the Lord Jesus Christ.
