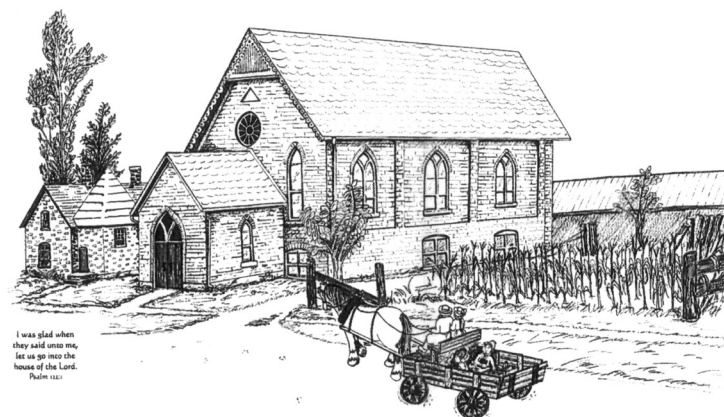


Administrative notes – please speak to Marcie about any of these items:
