- for our Candidate Orientation in November and those coming to it

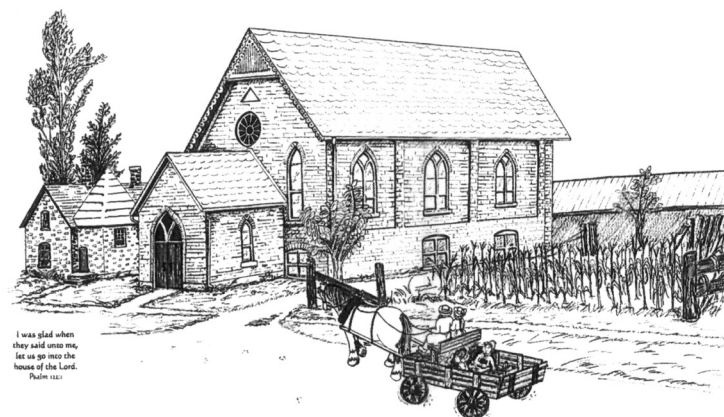
Praise God for the addition of 2 more grandchildren to our family.
