<b>THE WOUND</b>	Naming the lie, its cultural and theological roots, and the specific shame single men carry in silence.
<b>THE TRUTH</b>	What Scripture (KJV) actually says about singleness — including the radical fact that Jesus himself was single.
<b>THE LIFE</b>	Brotherhood, purpose, loneliness, lust, and dating — plus a full chapter for the man with a complicated history.
<b>THE CHURCH</b>	An honest conversation about how the church has failed single men — and how both the church and the man can do better.
<b>FORWARD</b>	Whether or not marriage ever comes — how to live as a whole, purposeful, Christlike man right now.
