

## Weekly Sermon Discussion Guide

Using the 4 R's: Reveal • Restore • Respond • Reach

### 1. REVEAL – What does this teach us about God?

- What truth about God or His nature stood out to you from this week's sermon?
- What did this passage or message reveal about what God values or desires?
- How did you see God's character—His love, justice, mercy, or holiness—displayed?
- What surprised or reminded you about who God is?

### 2. RESTORE – How does the gospel speak into this?

- How did this sermon point you to Jesus and the good news of the gospel?
- Where do you see our human brokenness or need for restoration in light of this message?
- What does this teach us about how Jesus restores what's broken in us or the world?
- How can the truth of the gospel bring hope or healing to the situation the message addressed?

### 3. RESPOND – What will I do with this truth?

- How is God calling you to respond to what you heard?
- What change in attitude, action, or perspective is needed this week?
- Is there a specific step of faith, forgiveness, or obedience you feel prompted to take?
- How can you depend on the Holy Spirit to help you live this out?

### 4. REACH – How can I share this or live it out with others?

- Who in your life needs to experience this truth through your words or actions?
- How might this week's message shape how you love or serve others?
- What opportunities do you see to bring the hope of the gospel into your everyday circles?
- How can our group encourage one another to reach out or live on mission this week?

### Close in Prayer

- Thank God for what He revealed.
- Ask for His power to restore and transform you.
- Pray for courage and compassion to reach others with His love.
