

A CROP Walk Success Story

Under beautiful fall skies, 72 Christians representing ten churches in Cass County gathered at the 36th annual **CROP** Walk to support Church World Services (CWS) programs. This year's walk raised a total of \$19,353, a record for the county. Five local pantries will receive 25% of the total funds raised, or \$968


each. Hope donated over \$5000 and was only \$106 behind the church that received the Heavenly Hightop Award for raising the most money,

Walkers enjoyed the information booths about CWS, including chickens for sustainable farming, methods of purifying water, and our own Diane Seifert providing a demo of fruit and vegetable dehydration (a new program operated by solar equipment for villagers without electricity). Walkers were also treated to snacks, a craft, and a couple of walkers in costume.


