

Rules Governing The Meeting Place Christmas Craft & Bake Sale

1. Tables will be pre-assigned, and you will be provided with your table placement prior to the Craft & Bake Sale. To ensure you are not placed by someone who sells similar products, please provide as much detail in your application as possible, including such requests as electrical/non-electrical, additional chairs, etc. Although we cannot guarantee these requests will be accommodated, we will do our best to do so.
2. Set up time is from 8:30am to 9:45am on Saturday, November 14, 2026. Please ensure that you are set up by 9:45am the latest. Your display must remain in place until 3:00 pm (i.e. do not start packing up earlier than that time). Our Craft Sale Volunteer Team will be on site during the entire craft sale, so please feel free to ask for assistance at any time. We will have volunteers on-site to assist you with carrying in your items. However, to ensure the health and safety of our volunteers, they will only handle boxed items or those of a similar size. Unfortunately, they will not be able to carry oversized or heavy items. Thank you for your understanding!
3. You will be provided with one 4' or 6' table and one chair. Please be respectful of the crafters/vendors beside you and keep within the space assigned to you. If you require another chair, please ensure you indicate that on your application. Oversized displays will not be permitted unless approved via email in advance.
4. Crafters/vendors are responsible for their own permits/licenses for selling their products as required by the Province of Manitoba and/or the City of Winnipeg. They are also responsible for all items required to ensure their booth runs smoothly including cash boxes, extension cords, table cloth, etc.
5. Tables must be staffed at all times during the sale.
6. Entire payment of your entry fee will be required by July 26, 2026:
 - If payment is not made within that time period, your application will be considered passed and we will move on to the next crafter/vendor
 - If you have paid your entry fee but do not attend the event, no refund will be given and you will be disqualified from this and future markets
 - If you are accepted as a vendor and have paid your entry fee but can no longer attend, please contact us ASAP (tduff@themeetingplace.mb.ca) to let us know. If your table can be replaced with another crafter/vendor of our choosing by October 1, 2026, we will issue a refund (less a \$10 administration fee)
