YOUR JOURNEY DAY BY DAY

Day 1 | Thursday, Apr. 8: Arrival & Coastal Welcome

"And I will give to you and to your offspring after you the land of your sojournings..." (Gen 17:8)

Our sacred journey begins as we land at Ben Gurion Airport at 16:00. We are met by our professional "smile assistance" team who will handle all portorage, allowing us to focus on the weight of being in the Holy Land for the first time.

We transfer to the Mediterranean coast, settling into our hotel in Netanya. This evening is a time for rest and quiet anticipation, looking out over the sea as we prepare our hearts for the encounters ahead.

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO PLAZA NETANYA

Day 2 | Friday, Apr. 9: Victory on the Heights & The Life of Jesus

"And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up..." (Luke 4:16)

We start our first full day with a **Private Church Service** to dedicate our pilgrimage to the Lord. We then explore **Caesarea Maritima**, a magnificent Roman port where we will see the theater and aqueduct, and remember the site where Peter preached to commissioned, marking the first Gentile conversion.

We ascend **Mt. Carmel** to witness the site of Elijah's dramatic victory over the prophets of Baal. In the afternoon, we visit **Nazareth Village**, a living history museum that recreates the agricultural and domestic life Jesus would have known, followed by a visit to **Sepphoris**, the nearby ancient "Jewel of the Galilee."

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO CLUB TIBERIAS

Day 3 | Saturday, Apr. 10: The Ministry of the Galilee

"And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues..." (Matt 4:23)

Today is a day of deep reflection on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. We visit the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, overlooking the water, to hear the Sermon on the Mount anew. At **Tabgha**, we see the mosaics commemorating the Multiplication of Loaves and Fish.

We enter **Capernaum**, the base of Jesus' Galilean ministry, to see the ruins of Peter's house and the ancient synagogue. After exploring the recently discovered first-century synagogue at **Magdala**, we conclude with a powerful **Worship Boat Ride**. As the engines stop in the middle of the lake, we enjoy a time of singing and silence on the same waters Jesus calmed.

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO CLUB TIBERIAS

Day 4 | Sunday, Apr. 11: The Northern Frontier & Modern Valor

"Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God." (Matt 16:16)

We journey north to the **Dan Nature Reserve**, walking along the headwaters of the Jordan River to see the Canaanite and Israelite gates. We visit **Caesarea Philippi** (Baniyas), the site where Peter made his great confession of faith.

In the afternoon, we gain a perspective on modern Israel at **Mt. Bental**, offering a panoramic view into Syria. We watch the moving short film **Oz 77**, learning about the heroic stand of the Israeli tank corps in the Valley of Tears during the 1973 Yom Kippur War, bridging ancient prophecy with modern survival.

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO CLUB TIBERIAS

Day 5 | Monday, Apr. 12: The Jordan Valley & Baptism

"Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29)

Departing the Galilee, we visit **Ein Harod** (Gideon's Spring), where we see the water where 300 men were chosen to serve the Lord. We explore the massive Roman and Byzantine ruins of **Beit Shean**, one of the grandest archaeological sites in the Middle East.

Our day culminates at **Kasr-El-Yahud** on the Jordan River. This traditional baptismal site provides a holy space for reflection on our own faith as we stand at the waters where John the Baptist ministered and Jesus was baptized.

OVERNIGHT: DAVID DEAD SEA RESORT

Day 6 | Tuesday, Apr. 13: Desert Strength & Jerusalem Entrance

"And went unto the place of which God had told him." (Gen 22:3)

We ascend the cable car to the top of **Masada**, the mountain fortress where we hear the story of the Jewish zealots' determination. We visit **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, revealing the miraculous preservation of the Word.

In the afternoon, we experience **Genesis Land** in the Judean desert for a **Camel Ride** and authentic desert hospitality, stepping into a living scene of the Patriarchs. We finally ascend to Jerusalem, arriving in time for the dramatic **Sound and Light Show** at the David Citadel to see the history of the Holy City unfold on ancient walls.

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO JERUSALEM

Day 7 | Wednesday, Apr. 14: The Passion & Mt. Zion

"And they led Jesus away to the high priest..." (Mark 14:53)

This morning is dedicated to the final hours of Jesus' life. We visit the **House of Caiaphas** (St. Peter in Gallicantu) to see the dungeons where Jesus was held. On **Mt. Zion**, we visit the Upper Room and the Tomb of King David.

We then walk the **Way of the Cross** (Via Dolorosa) through the bustling Old City, ending our morning at the site of the crucifixion and burial. In the late afternoon, we join the crowds at the **Western Wall** (Kotel) to witness the beautiful and stirring start of the Shabbat in Jerusalem.

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO JERUSALEM

Day 8 | Thursday, Apr. 15: Mount of Olives & Bethlehem

"For unto you is born this day... a Savior..." (Luke 2:11)

We stand on the **Mt. of Olives** for a breathtaking view of the Temple Mount, then walk the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** to pray among the ancient olive trees.

We enjoy a time of communion and celebration at the **Garden Tomb**, an alternative site for the empty tomb that offers a peaceful setting for worship. In the afternoon, we travel to **Bethlehem** to visit Manger Square and

the Church of the Nativity, celebrating the birth of the Savior.

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO JERUSALEM

Day 9 | Friday, Apr. 16: Foundations of the Kingdom

"And the congregation... assembled together at Shiloh..." (Joshua 18:1)

We travel north to **Ancient Shiloh**, the religious center of Israel for 369 years where the Tabernacle stood. Returning to Jerusalem, we explore the **City of David**, walking through the ancient water tunnels to see the foundations of the royal city.

After visiting the **Temple Institute** to see the preparations for the Third Temple, we explore the **Western Wall Tunnels** (Rabbi's Tunnels), standing close to the Holy of Holies.

This evening, we gather for our final dinner together in the Holy Land. Following our meal, we will meet in a private room for a special time of reflection on our shared journey. We will distribute official pilgrim certificates and share a meaningful time of farewell as we prepare for our return home.

OVERNIGHT: LEONARDO JERUSALEM

Day 10 | Saturday, Apr. 17: Return Home

At 03:30, we transfer to the airport for our 07:00 flight back home. We depart with the Bible in color, carrying the sights, sounds, and spiritual encounters of the Holy Land in our hearts forever.

1. Registration and Final payment due at the time shown in tour details. Late payment will be subject to availability and changes in fare may apply.
2. Cancellation Policy: Cancellations must be emailed as shown in tour details.
3. Cancellation Penalties: will apply as shown in tour details.
4. Forced Single: In the event, a roommate cannot be found for an individual requesting a roommate, the single room surcharge (according to tour details) will be charged to the passenger being placed in a single room.
5. All arrangements for transport, accommodation, services and other matters relating to the tour are made by your operator shown in tour details.
6. The Operator reserve the right to alter the cost of the tour due to an increase in the cost of tour services provided and/or foreign currency variation, to alter the route if international frontiers are not open, to decline any application, to exclude any participant from further participation if there is a health risk to body or mind, and to alter, without prior warning, excursions, or optional tours.
7. Neither the operator nor any employee, agent nor associate of the operator can accept any responsibility for personal belongings and baggage which remain the responsibility of the tour participant throughout the tour.
8. Regarding compensation and the limitations regarding compensation: Neither the operator nor any employee, agent or associate of the operator can be held responsible for a party or parties not involved in providing the services which make up your tour, or too unusual or unforeseeable circumstances whose consequences could not have been avoided or anticipated even when exercising all due care. Compensation is also conditional upon you assigning to us any rights you may have against any other person whose acts or omissions have given rise to our liability. The operator ability to compensate you and the amount of such compensation is subject to the following limitations: First, in the case of damage other than death, illness or personal injury, compensation is restricted to a reasonable amount having regard to such factors as, among other things, the tour cost and the extent to which the enjoyment of your tour can be said to have been affected. Second, in all cases, liability and compensation are limited in accordance with the provisions of all international conventions which concern transportation and accommodation, namely Warsaw Convention 1929 (including as amended by the Hague Protocol 1955), the Bern Convention 1961, the Athens Convention 1974, the Geneva Convention 1973, and the Paris Convention 1962. Copies of these conventions are available on request (please allow 28 days).
9. Your passport cannot expire 6 months after your entrance date to Israel. Non USA nationals must check entry and visa requirements with the relevant authorities. All passport and visa requirements are the responsibility of the passenger; Neither the operator nor any employee, agent or associate of the operator accepts responsibility for passengers' failure to comply with immigration requirements or passengers' failure to appear in time for scheduled departures.
10. The operator shall be entitled to assume that each tour participant is physically and mentally fit. Israel's rugged, steep terrain coupled with motor coaches and some tour sites being unable to accommodate persons with mobility issues make it nearly prohibitive for those requiring the use of a walker or wheelchair to participate. Persons requiring wheelchairs must provide their own wheelchair and person or persons to push the wheelchair throughout the tour. the operator and/or the guide will determine the times when site inaccessibility requires that the person requiring a wheelchair or walker must remain in the hotel.
11. the operator accepts no liability if there has been no fault on the operator part nor on the part of the operator suppliers when the loss, death or personal injury suffered is attributable to a tour participant's own acts or omissions or to the acts or omissions of a third party.
12. The operator will not pay compensation if cancellation or change should, in the opinion of the operator, become necessary as a result of civil unrest, strikes, disaster, pandemic, terrorist activities, technical problems with transportation, closure of airports, governments' regulations, alterations or cancellations of scheduled services, or other events outside the control of the operator.
13. If any hotel is unable to provide the accommodation reserved, the operator may substitute an alternative hotel of similar or higher classification at no extra cost or, alternatively, a lower classification of hotel subject to the refund of the difference in cost to the operator.
14. The price of your travel arrangements is subject to surcharges on the following items for increase in transportation costs (e.g. fuel), scheduled airfares and any other airline surcharges which are part of the contract between airlines (and their agents) and the tour operator/organizer, government action such as increase in V.A.T or any government-imposed increase, changes in currency in relation to adverse exchange rate variations. Even in this case, the operator will absorb an

amount equivalent to 2% of the tour price, which excludes insurance premiums, and any amendment charges. Only amounts in excess of this 2% will be surcharged. In return for this undertaking, the operator reserves the right not to pass on any credit due to favorable currency movement.

15. The operator reserve the right to cancel your tour as all tours operate subject to a minimum number of participants.

16. If any tour participant suffers death, illness or injury while overseas arising out of an activity which does not form part of the foreign tour arrangement or excursion arranged through us, the operator shall, at our discretion, offer advice, guidance, and assistance to help you in resolving any claim you may have against a third party provided the operator is advised of the incident within 90 days of the occurrence. Where legal action is contemplated, the operator authority must be obtained prior to commencement of proceedings and be subject to your undertaking to assign any costs recovered or any benefits received under an appropriate insurance policy to the operator. Our cost with respect to the above on behalf of you and your party shall not exceed \$5,000 in total.

17. Any complaint with respect to the tour must be registered with the operator's agents on the spot and in writing to the operator within 28 days of the return travel. the operator cannot accept responsibility for any complaints unless these procedures are followed.
