Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
2. What do you think? How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
3. What will you do? How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

1. When you think about your past, what moments or seasons tend to surface first?
2. Have you ever felt defined by something you did, something done to you, or something said about you?
3. Why do you think our past can feel so powerful in shaping how we see ourselves?
4. What surprised you most about Mary Magdalene's story?
5. How do you relate to being misunderstood, judged, or labeled by others?
6. Why do you think Jesus intentionally chose people with complicated pasts to follow Him?
7. When you look in the mirror, is it easier to see your past—or who God says you are?
8. What is one truth from this message you want to carry with you this week?
