# CHURCH PLANTING



## BOLD CHURCH

Bold Church is launching in the Fall of 2026 in Erie, Colorado. Their mission is to see lives transformed by the power of Jesus. They are committed to building a church that doesn't just gather on Sundays but makes an impact every day — a church marked by prayer, fueled by bold faith, and focused on reaching the lost in their city and beyond.

## DEVO CHURCH

Devo church is a recent church plant just outside of downtown Denver. Their mission is to lead people to become deeply devoted disciples of Jesus. Since launching in February '24, they have baptized over 85 people. God is putting together a vibrant and diverse community at DEVO that is on mission to leave a lasting impact and reach the one who is far from God.

## GENERATIONS CHURCH

Generations Church is a multi-generational church that loves the city of Eugene, loves the Oregon Ducks, and desires to make a generational impact on their city for the glory of Christ. They opened their doors in January of 2024 and already have baptized 91 people and are averaging over 600 people every Sunday. As their name implies, they are passionate about reaching the next generation!

## MANNA CHURCH

Manna Church Hawaii has seen over 1000 people make commitments to Christ and baptized over 300 since they launched in 2017. Now they are in a new season of trying to get into their own permanent building. As a church, we want to invest in others taking this leap of faith, as other churches invested in us.

## STRATEGIC LAUNCH NETWORK (SLN)

SLN is a network of like-minded churches, leaders, and friends working together to start strategic, high-impact churches in North America, with a focus on reaching people who do not know Jesus.

## THERE ARE SEVERAL WAYS TO GIVE:

1. You can give online at [www.frontrange.org](http://www.frontrange.org). Select “Give” and click the Give Online Button. You will be redirected to our Secure Giving Platform where you can select our “Love In Action” fund.
2. You can give directly through the Church Center app (search for “Church Center” in your app store).
3. Simply text the word “Give”, a dollar amount and the word “Love” to (888) 893-6119 (e.g. Give 50 Love) to be able to give directly from your phone.

## WHAT’S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE REGULAR OFFERING AND THIS SPECIAL OFFERING?

The regular offering is what you are used to giving to the church throughout the year. A special offering is on top of that regular generosity. Throughout the Bible, there are times where God would ask people to give a sacrificial offering such as a “freewill” or “thank” offering. Love In Action should be over and above what you regularly give so that Front Range can be in a position to make a greater impact in our city and around the world.

## HOW MUCH SHOULD I GIVE?

Our goal is HUGE and we know in order to reach \$250,000, Love In Action must involve everyone, including our kids and students. Please prayerfully consider a sacrificial gift that will stretch your faith in God and encourage you to give out of joy. The exact amount is between you and God. Some in our church will be able to give more than others. Pray about it, give joyfully and watch God use our generosity to be a blessing to so many. The goal is not equal giving, but equal sacrifice.

## WHEN SHOULD I GIVE?

Love In Action is designed to help people have time to pray, save up and make sacrifices that will enable all of us to bring our best gift. You may give anytime between now and December 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2025. We are aware that some of us may need to wait until January to give because of year-end bonuses or other unique circumstances. If you must make a gift after December 7<sup>TH</sup>, please let us know so we can plan accordingly.
