## Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. **What did you hear?** *What point in this message was most impactful for you?*
2. **What do you think?** *How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?*
3. **What will you do?** *How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?*

## Message Points/Extra Questions

1. How do meals and tables serve as a place for connection and equality?
2. Can you share a personal experience where a meal brought people together despite differences?
3. Share your own experiences of being welcomed to a table where you felt out of place. How did it impact you?
4. How can we create an environment of openness and acceptance at our own tables?
5. Share your thoughts on the idea that God calls the unlikely to change the world. Have you ever felt unlikely to be used by God?
6. Reflect on a time when you felt called to do something outside your comfort zone. How did you respond?
7. What steps can you take to be open to God's call in your life?
8. Reflect on how you can come to the table that Jesus has prepared for you. Consider how you can invite others to the table, especially those who may feel unwanted or unlikely.
