Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. **What did you hear?** *What point in this message was most impactful for you?*
2. **What do you think?** *How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?*
3. **What will you do?** *How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?*

Message Points/Extra Questions

1. How do you think the persecution and struggles of Christians at the time influenced the tone and content of John's letters?
2. Discuss the different issues each church faced, such as losing love for God, fearing persecution, compromising theology or morals, being spiritually dead, experiencing a spiritual awakening, or being complacent. Which of these situations do you personally relate to most? Why?
3. How can knowing Jesus is with us change our view of God, ourselves, and our circumstances?
4. What is the significance of God's love for us never wavering? How does this influence our daily decisions and mindset?
5. Considering the messages in the letters, how should we respond to God's invitation to a deeper relationship?
6. What steps can we take to help others understand and experience the presence and love of Jesus?
