Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
2. What do you think? How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
3. What will you do? How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

1. David writes "The Lord is MY shepherd" — not just "a" shepherd. What's the difference between knowing about God and having a personal relationship with Him?
2. A shepherd provides protection, guidance, and care for sheep. Which of those three do you feel you most need from God right now, and why?
3. Ernest said most of us don't like to see ourselves as sheep — we'd rather be seen as independent and capable. Why is it hard to embrace dependence on God? What makes trusting His way difficult?
4. How do you currently recognize or hear God's voice? What "voices" in your life tend to compete with or drown it out?
5. David says "I lack nothing" — meaning he had everything he needed, not everything he wanted. Is there an area of your life where you struggle to trust that God is providing enough? What would contentment look like there?
6. What is one practical step you can take this week to know His voice, trust His way, or receive His provision?
