Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

- 1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
- 2. **What do you think?** How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
- 3. **What will you do?** How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

- 1. Read Luke 7:36-50. What stands out to you about the interactions between Jesus, the Pharisee, and the woman?
- 2. The woman in Luke 7 pushes through embarrassment, shame, and judgment to get to Jesus. What barriers most often keep you from admitting your need for Him?
- 3. Why do you think pride is such a universal obstacle to healing—spiritually, emotionally, or relationally?
- 4. Is there an area of life where you're currently saying, "I've got this," even though you need help? What might it look like to bring that to Jesus?
- 5. Jesus offers the woman both forgiveness *and* peace. Which of those do you tend to struggle to actually receive—and why?
- 6. Where do you see yourself in this story—more like Simon the Pharisee or more like the woman? Why?
