Scriptures: Matthew 7: 7-11, Luke 11: 13, Mark 10: 46-52

Three Essential Questions

These are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
2. What do you think? How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
3. What will you do? How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

1. Do you find it easy to ask God for things, or do you tend to hesitate? Why?
2. Read Matthew 7:7-11. What stands out to you about these verses?
3. How would you describe your view of God today? Do you naturally see Him as a loving Father who gives good gifts, or do you sometimes view Him differently?
4. Can you think of a season when God's presence sustained you even when your prayer wasn't answered the way you hoped?
5. Read Mark 10:46-52. What do you notice about Bartimaeus' persistence? What can we learn from his willingness to keep asking even when others tried to silence him?
6. What makes it difficult to continue asking when the answer seems delayed or unclear?
7. Have you ever experienced God changing your heart while you were waiting for an answer? What did that process teach you?
8. The challenge from the message was to use the Lord's Prayer as a framework for daily prayer and specifically to personalize "Give us today our daily bread." What is a "daily bread" need in your life right now? What would it look like to consistently bring that request before God this week?
