Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
2. What do you think? How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
3. What will you do? How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

1. Why do you think the disciples struggled so much to believe Jesus would rise, even though He said He would?
2. Mary sees Jesus but doesn't recognize Him at first. Why do you think grief and pain can make it harder to recognize what God is doing?
3. Jesus speaks Mary's name, and she "turned to Him." What do you think that moment teaches us about how Jesus meets people personally?
4. What's the difference between optimism and true Christian hope?
5. The first thing Jesus says to the disciples is "Peace be with you." Why do you think peace was the first gift He gave them after the resurrection?
6. Which of the three do you need most right now: Hope, Peace, or Purpose?
7. What is one step you can take this week to respond to Jesus in that area?
