Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
2. What do you think? How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
3. What will you do? How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

1. What does it practically look like to "be strong in the Lord" instead of being strong in yourself?
2. In what areas of your life are you most tempted to rely on your own resources (income, intelligence, personality, control)?
3. Why do you think God consistently told leaders in Scripture to be courageous because He was with them?
4. Why is it so easy to misidentify people as the enemy?
5. Where do you see Satan's tactics at work right now (lies, division, accusation, fear, distraction, temptation)?
6. What does "standing firm" look like in everyday life?
7. If your prayer life were examined, would it look more like a "domestic intercom" or a "wartime walkie-talkie"?
8. What keeps you from praying with urgency or perseverance?
9. How might your prayers change if you saw yourself as recruited for battle?
