Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

- 1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
- 2. **What do you think?** How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
- 3. **What will you do?** How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

- 1. Icebreaker: Are there choices you've made in life that you now look back on with either regret or satisfaction?
- 2. Can you recall a time when you faced a trial and found it hard to consider it joy as suggested in James 1:2-4?
- 3. What is the significance of the "I Am" statement in John 15:1, and how does it relate to the concept of abiding in Christ?
- 4. How does the visual comparison of the vine and branches help you understand the call to remain in Jesus and bear fruit?
- 5. Discuss the ways to remain in Jesus' love and presence daily (e.g., prayer, Bible reading, worship, etc.). How can you incorporate these practices in your life?
- 6. In what ways can you demonstrate the love of Christ to those around you?
- 7. How can your group support each other in choosing to remain in God's love, obey His commands, and love others?
