## Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. **What did you hear?** *What point in this message was most impactful for you?*
2. **What do you think?** *How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?*
3. **What will you do?** *How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?*

## Message Points/Extra Questions

1. Do you have any examples of reality not meeting expectations?
2. How do the scenes in Revelation 4 challenge your perspective of worship?
3. In chapter 5, how do the contrasting images of strength and sacrifice broaden your understanding of Jesus?
4. How does this concept of victory through sacrifice challenge societal views on power and strength?
5. How does the truth that “the war has already been won” impact your approach to life’s challenges?
6. How can you remain steadfast in your faith despite external pressures?
7. How can you act more like Jesus in embodying truth and grace (John 1:17, Phil. 2: 3-8)?
8. How can worship reset your perspective?
