Three Essential Questions

The following questions are intended to be open-ended and encourage members to consider how they felt and what they, or the group, can do as a result of hearing the message.

1. What did you hear? What point in this message was most impactful for you?
2. What do you think? How did this message challenge, change, or affirm your thinking?
3. What will you do? How will you or your group put into practice what you've learned today?

Message Points/Extra Questions

1. The message talked about unmet expectations often leading to disappointment and broken trust. Have you ever felt disappointed with God because He didn't do what you expected?
2. Psalm 118 begins with gratitude: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." Why is gratitude often the hardest thing to practice when life feels painful?
3. The message emphasized that when life doesn't go our way, we should look to God's character first. What does it mean to focus on God's goodness even when circumstances feel unfair?
4. Where do you typically run for refuge when life feels overwhelming (people, distractions, control, entertainment, etc.)?
5. What are practical ways someone can "find refuge in Jesus" this week?
6. Why do you think worship has the power to change our perspective?
7. Which of the three responses do you need most right now?
 - a. Give Thanks
 - b. Find Refuge in Jesus
 - c. Worship
8. What is one specific way you can practice that this week?
