

# Start streaming computer (laptop)


## Power on laptop

Press power button (upper righthand corner of keyboard)

Username gsbush: no password (leave blank)


Should login automatically when powered on

Once all applications are loaded, click on the icon in the top right that looks like a circle with a line through it and select indefinitely





Launch OBS




Select PIP






Click login in upper right, username and password will auto fill, then select login



Click Restream from the menu




In Facebook live select Facebook UI




Takes you too Facebook:


On the left from the dropdown select "Post to page you manage"

Enter the day and date in the title and description

Example: Sunday, June 5th, 2022

Click save button.

## Return to OBS Application

Once worship team is done practicing and sound checks done, you can start streaming by clicking the Start Streaming button in OBS.

Once you start streaming, return to the Facebook page you have just setup the live stream on the church Facebook page.

Once the video feed is getting to Facebook (shows in the setup page you just did above, the go live button in lower left of page will be clickable and green. Go ahead and click go live there and return to the OBS application to monitor the stream.

Once the service is done, and the worship plays there last song after service you can click on Stop Streaming in OBS.

Everything else should take care of itself.

Quit Chrome and OBS, then shutdown the laptop and the desktop computer.
