## Commitment to showing up on time for rehearsals and services

- We value everyone's time so showing up on time allows rehearsal to start on time
- Punctuality is not only courteous, but also necessary. If you are unable to attend
  practice, other arrangements will be made or you'll be rescheduled for another
  week.
- We highly encourage you to help with setup and/or tear down as well as sit in the audience to listen to the message.

#### **Preparation** of musical material before showing up for rehearsals

• We do our best to send songs and charts out in advance. Everything you will need for the setlist will be on Planning Center. Worship team members are not only expected to look over and practice the material sent to them, but also to practice regularly and be growing as a musician.

#### Sensitivity and Modesty in dress

- This is a highly visible ministry, serving people with a wide range of taste & spiritual maturity.
- Aim to be "presentable" when choosing clothes that express your personal style; please
  dress modestly and neatly (No shorts, for females, skirts and dresses must be below
  the knee.)

#### **Submissiveness** to the worship leaders and worship ministry

# **Living Above Reproach – Commitment to a Godly Lifestyle**

# (I Timothy 3:2-3, Titus 1:6-7)

We at Doxa Church hold a very high standard of what it means to live above reproach, especially when it comes to this particular volunteer leader role. Since our worship team is in front of many people during the week, people see us as examples of what a Christ follower should be like. Our interactions with others are to be of such moral quality that they do not bring shame or in any way dishonor the body of Christ or the name of Jesus. This holds true not only inside the walls of the church, but outside the walls as well.

Above reproach, does not mean without sin. No Christ-follower lives an entirely sinless life. Above reproach means that a leader's life is free from sinful habits or behaviors that would prevent this person from setting the highest Christ-like standard and model for the church to follow (Hebrews 13:7; 1 Peter 5:3).

This person also must not give cause for those outside the church to question its reputation. Being above reproach means that no one can honestly bring a charge or accusation against you (Acts 25:7; 1 Peter 3:16).

In essence, the church's volunteer leaders must be one whose character is blameless and who is possibly esteemed highly within their inner circle of friends or their community. Such individuals are known for their wholesome life and faultless integrity. Overall they are individuals of good character and reputation.

So it is God's desire and our desire to see our worship team members grow closer to Jesus. If there are any issues or addictions that you struggle with, please let us know – we are here to help you, not to judge you.

Below are a few of the following issues that should be dealt with before any up-front or on-stage worship team volunteer position is taken:

- Alcohol and drug abuse
- Sexual immorality
- Living in with your boyfriend/girlfriend, not married
- Prideful attitude
- Anger and rage problems
- Inability to submit to leadership
- · Gossiping and stirring up strife
- An unbiblical lifestyle
