

Week 1 - Hebrews 10:22-25

- Why do you attend church?
- What are some reasons you see in these verses to attend church with others?
- What are some things that keep people from coming to church sometimes?
- Our verses talk about habits (v25), specifically the habit of NOT meeting together. Why do you think God puts great importance on meeting together as a church? What happens when you miss meeting together for several weeks in a row?

Activity

Either as a family or each individually, make an effort to look for someone at church this next week that you can encourage and/or spur them on to good deeds. Work together as a family to do that.

Week 2 - Psalm 148 & 150

- What kind of music do you like?
- What's the difference between "Christian" music and all other music?
- Why do you think we sing while we are at church?
- What should be our attitude or spirit while singing to God?
- Is anyone too old or too cool to sing to God?
- According to our verses, how are we to praise God and why?

Activity

Have a family time where you take turns listening to your favorite non-Christian song and then listen to your favorite Christian song. Talk about the differences. Is there a difference in words used, topics, way it makes you feel, etc.?

Week 3 - 1 Peter 4:10

- What gifts / talents / abilities do you have?
- How can you use those gifts to serve others?
- You also have other things God has given you ... toys, house, bike, car, food ...
- How can you use these things to serve others?
- According to our verse, how are we supposed to be serving others?
- How does serving others serve God?

Activity

Take a family walk around your neighborhood. As you walk see if there is an obvious need of one of your neighbors that you can help with. Then make a plan of when and how you will do it. Or do it right then if possible!

Week 4 - Matthew 28:19

- What are missionaries?
- How do missionaries fulfill our verse?
- Do you know what missionaries The Crossing supports?
- Do we all have to go to other countries to be missionaries and tell people about Jesus?
- How can you be a missionary at your school or work?
- Why do we need to tell others about Jesus?

Activity

The Vickio's in Italy and the Payne's in Japan are the missionaries we support. How can your family encourage them? How about making some creative cards / notes to send to them. Those will remind them that we are thinking about them and praying for them. Spend some time as a family praying for them now!
