

### Week 1 - 1 John 3:1

- What does "lavish" mean?
- According to this verse, who are we?
- What benefits come with being a Child of God?
- What responsibilities come with being a Child of God?
- If our Father is the King of kings, what does that make us as His children?
- How do princes and princesses carry themselves / How do they walk in a room? For example- with or without confidence?

#### Activity

Have a family movie night. Watch a movie about a prince or princess and then talk about the similarities and differences between a movie prince/princess and us as Children of God.

### Week 2 - Isaiah 64:8 & Psalm 139:13-14

- Who is the potter? Who is the clay?
- Does God make mistakes?
- If God designed us and created us, what does it tell God when we want to change how he designed and created us?
- We are made in order to praise Him. How can we as a family praise God together?

#### Activity

Get out the playdoh and create some masterpieces. As you are creating, talk about how God made each of you different, how are you the same, and how God gets to choose who we are when He makes us.

### Week 3 - 1 Peter 4:10-11

- What does this verse tell us we should be doing?
- Peter used speaking and serving as examples. Can you speak and serve?
- What other things has God given you that you can use for Him? (Hint: everything you have has been given by God whether it's talents or possessions.)
- Have each person tell 1 possession and 1 talent they have and how they can use it for God.
- We are to be using our gifts to serve others, represent God and give praise to God.

#### Activity

Plan a family talent show. Pick a night later in the week that you will have the show and let each person pick what talent they want to show and practice it and present it that night. Don't forget the popcorn!

### Week 4 - Colossians 1:16

- Have you ever used an object for something other than what it was created to do? (Example - butter knife as a screwdriver)
- God created us for Himself. But many times we live for ourselves.
- What happens when we live for ourselves instead of God?
- So how do we know what God wants us to do?
- The Bible tells us God's will for us. Do you read your Bible often? Why?

#### Activity

Take a family walk and talk about the things you like and don't like to do, the things you are good at and not so good at. After you have discussed all those things, is there anything that you feel like God might want you doing or things He wants you to be using for Him?
