

Week 1 - Revelation 21:3-4, 10-14 & 18-27

- Where is a place you are looking forward to going to some day?
- Before reading the text, tell us what you already know about Heaven & Hell.
- What can we learn about Heaven from our text today?
- What are you looking forward to the most about Heaven?
- What is Hell?
- Heaven is full of joy, light, love, laughter, relationship with Jesus, beauty, kindness, etc. Hell is full of fear, tears, darkness, loneliness, etc. Which one would you rather look forward to?

Activity

Make plans for somewhere you can go this summer. Talk about what you are looking forward to about it. Then talk about how Heaven is better than that place.

Week 2 - Mother's Day!! Proverbs 23:25

- Why are moms important?
- What does it mean to honor your mother?
- What makes your mom joyful?
- How can we each affect our mothers joy?
- Take turns telling the top 3 things you appreciate about your mom.

Activity

Turn this week into a Mother's Week instead of just a day! Do one thing each day that Mom enjoys. Each person in the family should do one chore that Mom usually does & give her a break. Have a party and focus on Mom - her favorites - food, dessert, games, etc.

Week 3 - Revelation 7:9, 13-14

- Do you want to go to Heaven someday?
- If no sin can enter Heaven, and we have all sinned, how do we get in Heaven?
- What are the white robes these verses talk about? How did they get white?
- What does following Jesus mean?
- How do we stay close to Jesus throughout our whole lives?
- Who gets us to Heaven?

Activity

Divide the family into 2 teams. Give each team a roll of toilet paper. On "go" each team has to wrap one person on their team with the toilet paper, giving them a "white robe".

Week 4 - Revelation 22:12-15

- What do red letters in the Bible mean?
- Discuss what each of these steps mean...
 - Hearing the message of Jesus
 - Believing that Jesus is the Son of God
 - Confessing that we have sinned and we can't get rid of it ourselves
 - Repenting of our sin
 - Connect ourselves to Jesus through baptism
 - Continue to live our lives as a Jesus follower

Activity

Go to a pool or the beach and talk about the difference between just going under water while your swimming and playing and the act of baptism. What makes it different?
