

Week 1 - The Easter Story - Luke 22:47-24:12

- What's your favorite part of the Easter story?
- What's your least favorite part?
- Why is the death of Jesus important for us?
- What do you think Jesus was thinking and feeling as He went through the arrest, trials, and crucifixion?
- What does the resurrection of Jesus mean for us?
- How can we celebrate Easter in a way that keeps the focus on what Jesus did for us rather than on candy and bunnies?

Activity

Make a set of resurrection eggs by drawing pictures to represent each part of the Easter story and placing each in an egg. Take turns hiding and finding the eggs and putting the eggs in the right order of the story.

Week 2 - Matthew 14:22, 25-33

- Why did the disciples think they were seeing a ghost?
- Why was Peter only able to take a few steps and then sank?
- Why was Jesus not afraid?
- What are you afraid of?
- How can Jesus help us overcome our fears?
- What does Jesus have power over?

Activity

Play a game of Sink or Float.

Have each family member find a small object around the house that can get wet. Fill a large container with water. Take turns placing the objects in the water. Before placing it in, everyone says whether they think it will sink or float.

Week 3 - Luke 17:11-19

- What is Leprosy?
- Because these men had leprosy, they couldn't be around other people because it was very contagious. How do you think that made them feel?
- Have you ever felt like that?
- How did Jesus heal them?
- How many of the healed men came back to thank Jesus?
- Do you think Jesus was disappointed that only 1 came back?
- What should our response to Jesus be for having power over everything?

Activity

Spend some time in a family praise and worship time. Maybe sing your favorite worship song, make praise statements to Jesus, thank Him for how He has shown His power in your lives. Come up with your own ideas of how to praise Him.

Week 4 - Luke 9:37-40 & 42-43a

- What is a demon?
- Does Jesus have power even over satan?
- How did Jesus heal this boy?
- If Jesus has power over everything, and we are His children, what does that mean for us?
- Do you have anything right now that makes you worry or fear?
- What other miracles of Jesus have you read about in the Bible?

Activity

Take a family walk and talk about the things that worry you or that you fear. Talk about ways you can go to Jesus with those things and what He can do about it.
