## Family Devotions based on Sundays lesson

### April 2025 - The Exodus

#### Week 1 - The Burning Bush - Genesis 50:22-24, & Exodus 1:6-14, 3:1-12a

- What would you do if you saw a burning bush?
- What does this story tell us about God's power?
- When was a time you were scared to do something but you did it knowing that God promises to be with you?

##### Activity

This is a great opportunity to do your family devotions around a fire pit!

#### Week 2 - The Plagues - Exodus 7-11

- What were the 10 plagues?
- Which of the first 9 do you think would be the worst?
- Why do you think Pharaoh was not letting the people go?
- When we don't listen and obey, what are the consequences?

##### Activity

Distribute 10 pieces of paper evenly to each family member. Assign each person one of the plagues until all 10 have been assigned. Then draw the plagues you were given. Talk about what would have been some of the negative issues with each plague.

#### Week 3 - Easter

- Read the Easter story together
- Talk about how the last plague, death of the firstborn, with the death angel passing over the blood covered doors, correlates with the Easter story of Christ's blood saving us.

##### Activity

Do a little research and do a passover meal with your family.

#### Week 4 - Crossing the Red Sea - Exodus 12:31-40, 14:1-31

- How was God's presence with them displayed?
- How does this story show us we can trust God and His plan?
- Who is our greatest enemy?
- Can God defeat even him? How do we know that?

##### Activity

Go to a river, stream, pond, or even the ocean and talk about what it would take to split the water, to have a wall of water on each side and the land to dry up enough to walk on without sinking.
