Scripture: 1 Samuel 17:1-50

Discussion Questions:

- What made David brave enough to face the giant?
- What do you face in your life that requires bravery?
- What did David tell Goliath right before he threw his stone?
- Who is the real Super Hero in this story?

Family Activity: Take a family walk in a place where everyone can find a smooth stone. When home, paint on the rock, "God fights for me!"

Scripture: Daniel 6

Discussion Questions:

- Who was Daniel?
- Why didn't the other leaders like him?
- Why did Daniel keep praying to God even though the law said not to?
- How do you think Daniel felt going in to the lions den?
- Why didn't the lions eat him?
- What makes you afraid?
- Who is the real Super Hero in this story?

Family Activity: Go to the zoo to visit the lions --- or ---

- Using paper plates, make a lion mask. On the back write, "My God sent His angel to shut the mouth of the lion."

Week 3 - April 21-27



Scripture: Daniel 3

Discussion Questions:

- Why did King Nebuchadnezzar build the statue?
- Why did Shadrach, Meshach & Abednego not want to bow down?
- When is it hard for you to do the right thing?
- Do you think having friends with them made it easier to stand up to the king?
- Who are your friends that you know will help you do the right things?
- How did they not get burned in the fire?
- Who is the real Super Hero in this story?

Family Activity: Have a family fire pit night and make smores. Talk about how big of a miracle it was for them to survive and not even smell like smoke.

Week 4 - April 28-May 4



Scripture: 1 Kings 18:16-39

Discussion Questions:

- What was the point of this challenge?
- Why did Elijah pour a lot of water on his altar?
- What do you think the people meant when they said at the end, "The Lord - He is God"?
- How did God show that He is the real Super Hero we need?

Family Activity: Take a few minutes to recommit yourselves to following God. Make a short list of words or phrases that you want to describe your family and that show you follow God in any situation.
