Discussion Points:

- Pick out one of the stories listed above to read
- What part did a donkey play?
- What happened after the donkey did his part?
- How can the small things we do for God make a big impact?

Family Activity: Gather the ingredients for a meal (ex.- spaghetti dinner) and carry it to a neighbor. Just because!!



Family Devos Oct. Week 3



Scripture: Luke 10:30-35, Romans 12:3-5

Discussion Points:

- Donkeys are very relational animals and once you show them they can trust you to protect them, they are very dependable work partners.
- How did the donkey help in this story?
- We all have an important part in God's plan. What do you think is your part in God's plan? How can you help other people?

Family Activity: Walk around your neighborhood and find someone your family can help. Find something for each family member to do in your plan to help them.



Family Devos Oct. Week 4



Scripture: Luke 19:28-38

Discussion Points:

- Why do you think Jesus chose to ride a donkey instead of a big, beautiful horse?
- God often uses the unexpected or unknown. Have you ever done something or accomplished something that people didn't think you could do?
- How can we show God we are willing to be used by Him for His purposes?

Family Activity: As a family, talk about ways God may want to use you as you go about your usual activities this week. Is there anything you need to do (or not do) to ensure you don't miss the opportunity?
