	Brad met with Jeff Simpson (head of the security team). They discussed the security policy (as a result of an incident two weeks ago.) Tomorrow night there will be a meeting where staff/security will be trained on AED (defibrillator) and CPR. The church has a need to recruit to this team. We are looking for people with the following backgrounds: military, law enforcement, medical, social work, mental health, criminal justice, etc.	
	The potential buyer has decided they are not interested in purchasing the church's property at this time. The team may look into others who have expressed an interest in purchasing the property. If the property is sold to another entity the church would likely need to share Ward Rd. access with whoever buys the property. About 1 acre or so nearby has sold for roughly \$700,000.	
	Roxi and Brad are still thankful and delighted to be a part of the church.	
	Somewhere between \$330-340,000 has been donated to the debt reduction campaign since it was brought up last November. Next month (likely) after we think all donations are in, Brad will request council's approval to send the full amount received to National Covenant Properties to pay down the mortgage.

Job Descriptions	A current org chart for the church needs to be created.	
	Jodi and Mike both wrote their own job descriptions—the council now needs to review them and go back to staff with suggestions. There is some overlap between the two job descriptions, and the council needs to ensure the staff do not have too much on their plate, and are capable of filling the roles they have in their job description. These job descriptions also need to take into account the possible skills of a new incoming pastor.
