Verses 2-6

1. How and for what are the Colossians commanded to pray? (also include verse 12)
2. What role is played in advancing the Gospel by any of the following:

3. List specific situations in which you can obey the commands concerning conduct and conversation.
4. Why is thankfulness such a key ingredient in a Christian's life (also see 2:7; 3:15, 17)?
5. From verses 5-6, what principles do you want to build into your life as you relate to non-believers?

Verses 7-18

6. In light of the influence of the false teachings, why would Paul's commendation of Epaphras be especially important? (1:7; 4:12-13)
7. Seeing how Paul operated with a team of fellow Christians, what does that imply for you? For your small group?
