Job 4:1–9; 5:17–27; 6:24–30; 23:1–17

A common narrative believers have is that bad things happen to someone because of sin.

Eliphaz encouraged Job to take ownership of his misperceived sin.

Eliphaz's arrogance undermines his argument.

Eliphaz and Job falsely assume they know the answers without understanding the greater context of what was really happening.

“If you judge people, you have no time to love them.” (Mother Theresa)

“Help me to understand because I don't”

Reflection: When did you misunderstand someone's words or actions and judge them for it?

Challenge: Pray for discernment and courage to apologize when you have been wrong.
