Declaring Hope

Week 1: Separation and Reunion

Scripture Passages: John 14:15-31; 2 Corinthians 5:11-21; Ephesians 2:8-10; 1 John 3:1-6; Galatians 2:19-21

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:
