COMMUNITY / FELLOWSHIP	Encourage one another to be rooted in hope, driven by love, expectant in faith and steadfast in prayer.	Allow the scriptures to lead us deeper into healing and wholeness as we immerse ourselves in God's word together.	Help all people discover the love of God through intergenerational, interdependent, and interconnected community.	Openly invite new people (neighbors and friends) into the vibrant spiritual life of the church by extending loving hospitality.
SERVICE	With eyes fixed on King Jesus, extend the hope and love of Christ by passionately responding to the gospel of grace through loving service.	Embrace and practice the life of service modeled by Jesus in the gospels. Grow in relationship with Jesus by living as his body.	Not only inviting the Holy Spirit in their gatherings, but following the leading of the Holy Spirit as needs arise in the church or out in the community.	Extend the unconditional love of Christ by becoming his hands and feet to care for and serve others while sharing the gospel.
STUDY	Remain steadfast in prayer and expectant that God will reveal Himself through His word. Become formed by Jesus as you are immersed in God's word.	Immerse yourself in the life-shaping truth of scripture, both individually and as a group, to encounter Jesus and walk in biblical integrity.	Practice messy vulnerability and go deeper into transparent relationships as the Holy Spirit illuminates scripture and opens hearts to deeper relationship.	Missional in the sense of discipleship. Caring for those who already have a relationship with Jesus and taking them deeper into God's word and the life of the church.
