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Declaring Hope

Week 3: Emptiness and Fulfillment

Scripture: Genesis 3, Psalm 8; Psalm 23; Matthew 6:25-27; Matthew 10:29-31; Matthew 16:21-27; Philippians 1:5-9; Philippians 2:1-13; Hebrews 2:17-18

Small Group Questions:

1. We are often so busy trying to achieve “more” in life and feel “significant” that we miss what matters the most. What have you spent your life working towards? How do you want to be remembered by your loved ones?
2. We often feel scarcity and insecurity in this life, but scripture speaks to our longing for more. What does it mean that we “lack nothing” when the Lord is our Shepherd (Psalm 23)?
3. How does the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus continually communicate that our lives have value? How do we see that God loves the world and loves us as individuals?
4. How can being a follower of Jesus help us escape the trap of needing to feel significant in an earthly sense with money, power, fame, etc.?
5. What has your own journey been like in experiencing God’s love and acceptance? Has it been easy or hard for you? What, if anything, is standing in the way of your fulfillment today?
