Gabriel says, "For nothing will be impossible with God" (Luke 1:37)	3. Nothing is impossible with God Question: Where do you secretly believe "this will never change"? How would your prayers and decisions shift if you truly lived like Luke 1:37 is true?

James 1:2–4 and John 16:33.	4. Responding to trials with maturity
Emmanuel (God with us) becomes the reality of God in us through the Spirit (Isaiah 7:14; John 20:21–22; Acts 2:38).	Question: What trial are you in (or avoiding) right now? What would "take heart" and "consider it joy" look like without pretending it doesn't hurt?
	5. From God with us to God in us Question: Do you relate to God more as "with me" or "in me"? What difference would it make in your daily life (work, marriage, anxiety, temptation) if you lived from the reality that the Spirit is in you?
