4. How would you identify the concentric circles of mission in your life and how are you involved in each?
 - a. Jerusalem
 - b. Judea and Samaria
 - c. The ends of the earth
5. What comes to mind when you think about being one of "Jesus' witnesses"? What are some practical ways we can all fulfill that?
