Revival Begins with Spirit Filled Repentance Acts 2:37-41 Community Group Questions

- 1. Read Acts 2:37-41. What did you find most helpful, encouraging or challenging from this week's passage and message? What questions do you have?
- 2. Verse 37 describes the response of the people to Peter's sermon. Have you ever been "cut to the heart" when hearing a message or reading your Bible? Describe a time when you experienced something like this.
- 3. Martin Luther said: "When our Lord and Master, Jesus Christ, said, 'Repent,' he intended that the entire life of believers should be repentance." What does it look like for Christians to have a rhythm of repentance or a lifestyle of repentance?
- 4. Baptism does not save us, but it is expected that every follower of Jesus will get baptized. Read the following passages on baptism: Acts 8:5-13; 8:36-38; 9:17-19; 10:47-48; 16:13-15; 16:27-34; 18:5-8; 22:14-17. What would you say to the person who professes to be a follower of Jesus but doesn't want to get baptized?
- 5. Read vv.38-39 again. How would you describe the interplay between God's sovereignty and human responsibility in salvation?
- 6. We have 6 baptisms taking place this Sunday. Spend some time praying for those taking this step of obedience.
