Acts 27:1-44

1. Read Acts 27:1-44. What did you find most helpful, encouraging or challenging from this week's passage and message?
2. "Despite all seeming evidence to the contrary, God will be faithful to fulfill His promises." What are some of the promises of God you are holding onto right now? How do you remind yourself of these truths when life feels chaotic?
3. "God has a purpose in all things – including trouble." Can you think of a hardship in your life later revealed God's purpose? How does this perspective affect how you handle trials now?
4. Paul demonstrates both faith and practical wisdom. Why do you think some people struggle to balance spiritual trust with practical responsibility? What are some ways we can grow in both areas?
5. Paul encourages others even while he himself is a prisoner in a dangerous situation. How can we encourage others when we are going through trials ourselves?
6. Read Jonah 1:1-10. What are the similarities and dissimilarities between Jonah and Paul? What are some situations where we can be an encouragement to others when hope is in short supply?
