2. What is one gift, benefit, or blessing that you appreciate more today than you did a few years ago?
3. How does our culture typically view human nature? How does Paul's description challenge that view?
4. Paul describes our condition as "weak," "ungodly," "sinners," and "enemies." Which of these descriptions stands out most to you, and why?
5. Pastor Lee mentioned that we are often shocked by God's judgment but not by His grace. Why do you think that is?
6. Why is it significant to that Christ died for us while we were still sinners rather than after we had changed?
7. Which of these substitutionary statements stands out to you most?
  - He was condemned so we could be declared innocent
  - He bore our shame so we could receive honor
  - He experienced defeat so we could have victory
  - He was cursed so we could be blessed
  - Or another one?
8. How does remembering what God has already done for you strengthen your confidence about the future?
