Community Group Questions Acts 6:1-7

- 1 Read Acts 6:1-7. What stood out to you as being particularly helpful or encouraging this week's passage and message?
- What is your usual reaction when you hear a discussion about "church governance"? Do your eyes gloss over? Are you keenly interested? Do you see it as a 'necessary evil'?
- 3 What has your experience been with seeing ways in which new growth can bring with it new problems? What do you think of the idea that churches are a mixture of vine and trellis? What dangers do you see in concentrating too heavily on either one of these?
- 4 Read Exodus 18:13-27. What wisdom do you glean from Jethro's counsel here? What similarities do you see between this passage and the one in Acts 6?
- 5 Read the list of qualifications for deacons in 1 Timothy 3:8-13. Are there any items on that list that surprise you? Why do you think there is such a heavy emphasis on issues of character and so little placed on skill?
- What are some practical things a church can do to ensure that it doesn't become distracted by 'the tyranny of the urgent,' but is able to fulfill its mission?
